Inauguration & Guest Lecture Series (July 2025)

Official launch of the Departmental activities for the session. Renowned regional biologists will be invited to interact with incoming students to contextualize career options in Zoology and allied research pipelines.

Vrukshabandhan / Rakshabandhan Activity (September 2025)

An eco-centric societal engagement project focused on environmental preservation and binding ecological responsibility to local traditions by adopting and protecting local flora species.

Zoological Society Presidential Election Meet (September 2025)

A student-centric regulatory meet conducted to democratically select the President, Secretary, and executive council members of the departmental Zoological Society, ensuring student governance integration.

Wildlife Week Celebration Portfolio (1st – 7th October 2025)

An expansive calendar consisting of essay competitions, wildlife photography galleries, guest expert webinars, and field sensitizations regarding regional biodiversity loss and fauna protection matrices.

Long Tour Planning Board (December 2025)

Strategic core meeting encompassing safety logistics compliance, route map authorization, regional biodiversity survey targeting, and regulatory permission acquisition for the annual Zoology study excursion.

Project-Related Activities & Collection Meets

Supervised practical exposure modules emphasizing systemic field sampling (e.g., sugarcane pest monitoring, collection protocol documentation) and research portfolio alignment for final-year students.

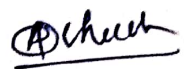
Sparrow Conservation Awareness Campaign & Nest Making Workshop (January 2026)
